A Note from the President: Peter and the Starcatcher

Peter and the Starcatcher bowed on Broadway April 15, 2011 after a very successful Off-Broadway run the previous year. It enjoyed another Off-Broadway run in 2013 at New World Stages that took it into 2014. It is yet another show, this season, that Town and Country Players has chosen to stage that originates from within the past 20 years. It was nominated for a host of awards during its New York run, including nine Tony Awards, going on to win an impressive five Tony Awards.

This idea of presenting fresh and significant plays suitable for the entire family is not new for Town and Country Players. Looking back over our rich history, there is a tradition of presenting many Family Friendly Musicals and shows based on cherished fairy and folk tales. The tradition of staging shows the entire family can enjoy but are adaptations of beloved books is also a strong one here at Town and Country Players: 2016 Holes is based on Louis Sachar's 1998 young adult novel of the same name, which was then made into a 2003 Disney movie; 2014 saw the staging of Anne of Green Gables at Town and Country, based on the cherished series of novels written by Lucy Maud Montgomery between 1908 and 1939; Little Women by Louisa May Alcott, based on her novel of the same name from 1868/1869 was presented as part of the 2010 season; The inspirational story of Helen Keller was presented in 1984 with The Miracle Worker, based on Keller's 1903 biography, The Story of My Life, and a 1957 radio play by William Gibson. The list goes on and on, but the tradition is clear— Town and Country Players continues to present newer works, often stage adaptations of classic favorites, in an ever-evolving mission to give our artistic community and patrons new and exciting viewing opportunities.






